General Information IMPORTANT. Mullaney wrote, Jan. 1, 1938, "The 2 clerestory windows on each side of the Transept Windows, the two small clerestory windows in the chancel and the other two in the nave have a different setting than any of the other windows - as they have a 12 foot wall around them and also a 12 foot ceiling on the outside". Do not overlook this.
