Description sent in letter: "...Elizabeth and The Blessed Virgin as central figures, symbolizing the Visitation. Below is a symbol of the home in Nazareth, with the pack donkey on the road to the City of Judah and Saint Joseph with his symbolic flowering staff, balanced by Zacharias with the censer. I have chosen the inscription from "the Magnificat" - the first Chapter of St. Luke - "My soul doth magnify the Lord"; and across the base, "His mercy is on them that fear him from generation to generation." figures small in scale and have struck a predominating note of clear fine blue throughout the field, surrounded by the decorative architectural canopy of a character similar to my neighboring windows. In the little tracery pieces are traditional monograms - the A.M. of Saint Mary and the I.H.C. of Our Lord."
