of one aisle window, 3/4" scale to the foot, and a small circular chancel window at the same scale.

2 small windows in stairhall leading to gallery 4' each

2 small windows in Baptistry - 4' each.

2 aisle windows, 5 north, 5 south. Footage 50 feet each. 5 feet from floor. (Looks like triple-hung wooden sash on blue print?)

1 Circle in chancel - West - slightly north - 16 feet - 23 feet from floor.

1 circle over entrance - East, slightly south. 9 feet.

4 other circles - 2 north, 2 south. 12' each. $13\frac{1}{2}$ feet from floor.

When we sent the designs wrote: "I have in mind using very light - practically white - tints of rough textured glasses, with the decorative enrichment in trace line, accented with gold stain. I have brought the border toward the inner muntin line so that a greater amount of the pattern would be visible at angles where a portion of the windows are obscured."
