We have suggested - beginning nearest the entrance on the south with with the Nativity, the Flight into Egypt, Presentation, the Baptism, First Miracle at Cana, the Good Shepherd, the Transfiguration in the rose; then continuing on the north side with the Light of the World, Christ at the Home of Mary and Martha, Blessing Little Children, the Good Samaritan, the Prodigal Son, Cleansing of the Temple, Triumphal entry, the Agony in the Garden, and the Crucifixion as culminating symbol in the west rose.
