General Information We are to make a color sketch - 1/2" scale on tracing paper - of one of the lower transept windows (also an aisle), and have ready to show to Father Crosby when he comes to Boston next Wednesday, April 6. The transepts are suggested at \$1500 each, or practically \$10 per foot. This can be adjusted up or down, so that the total for the whole church comes out somewhere around \$20,000. Full figures and medallions are suggested for the transept windows - possibly removing the upper divisions in the transepts on account of the figures.
