General Information Round headed window - for young girl - child of about ten.
Colorful border, rather simple leaded field, and a good sized medallion -
with secondary symbols above and below.

When we sent the sketch we wrote: "...I have suggested the arrangement of
tones through the border, the central medallion, and the smaller notes of
enrichment above and below. You will immediately see that I have chosen the
Guardian Angel theme as most appropriate for the young child. At first
I had started a composition representing Martha and Mary in the home at
Bethany, symbolizing the two-fold life of Christian service - Active and
Contemplative; but for the younger child, perhaps this is better.
For the test, I have suggested that significant eleventh verse of the
91st Psalm: "For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in

all thy ways."

I should keep the general field of the window fairly light in an interesting range of tints, with a generous use of gold and rich accents of pure ruby and blue.

The room in which it will be located is 12 feet in width and 18 feet high, and has a flat ceiling. The walls are principally white Alabama marble and the floor is marble and Terrazzo, generally of about the value of light coffee color.

*It is probable that the memorial window would require the removal of the present metal frame, and the substitution of a ventilator 18 inches to 2 feet in height.
