 Around the central windows in the chancel there are 12 shields at the
 bases, and we are thinking of the twelve apostles. Then there are seven
 others on the north in the chancel, and seven on the south. We thought of the
 Seven Gifts of the Spirit for one group of seven, but we are not sure of
 the others. Also in the front there are two under the Four Evangelists. My
 idea for them is Saint Peter and Saint Paul. (These are on the outside).
 Then there are two immediately above the entrance which I am not quite sure
 of. Then there are two in the rear on the inside - on either side of the
 entrance doors for which I have suggested Old Testament and New Testament.
 At the bases of the clerestory windows it might be well to have subjects
 related to the windows, that is, the Pilgrim's Progress, the symbols they
 speak of in The Palace Beautiful, and so on. Then there are eight great

big dominating ones around the transept crossing - right at the crossing -
and I should say the Eight Beatitudes should be there."
