one theme of this window is announced in the text from the one hundredth Pauls of David - fourth verse - "Enter into His gates with thanksgiving and into His courts with Praise." Angelic figures of Praise (above) and Prayer (below), with trumpet and censer, are accompanied by children's figures preising God and offering Him their prayers, and two Sandwich Glass roses in the base.

All are moven into a pattern of growing vine forms related to and harmonizing with the sisle and clerestory windows. They also flower in the fleur-de-lys of purity.
