General Information We have the actual wooden frame, and the panel of glass to be designed into it.

Make design to suggest method of filling the sash with the Crucifixion and with surrounding appropriate glass.

The purpose of the window is a memorial to Mr. Morris' wife - "any lettering should, I think, merely disclose that memorial; and the source of the gift would be preserved in the Fabric Accounts of the Cathedral.

This is a 13th century Spanish crucifixion

Note: these clerestory windows are in pairs; only one of the pair could be be used for this purpose. Mr. Morris is hoping that he may make provision for having the other of the pair ultimately filled by some memorial to himself.

*Window is reasonably high, but building is not very lofty.

Aug. 22. When we sent design we said, "I think that this is very effectively arranged with a colorful border, surrounding a lighter field of foliated grisaille - suggesting growing forms and supporting the little kneeling Angel of Prayer in colors closely related to the main panel."
