It would be very similar to the representation of him which we used in the great east window of Saint James Church, Albany. Perhaps the photograph of the black and white drawings of this window would give you a little clearer idea of the way the figure would actually be drawn.

You will easily identify Baint John as the right-hand figure balancing that of Our Lady in the central lancet heads.
