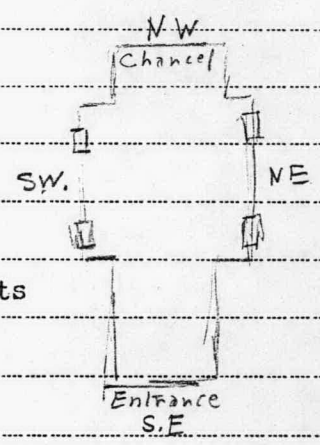

This would be eight figures. The Greek and Latin Doctors were suggested or the Evangelists and Prophets, but he thought he would have to consider this more thoroughly. We are to make a typical aisle window design and probably a supplementary one showing figures.
