General Information Father Dunney plans to make a war memorial Chapel out of the side transept where his windows are, leaving the altar, rail, and statues as they are - placing American flags in standards at either side and wonders if we can make suggestions as to how to drape flags or decorative ornaments of some kind over the top of the altar space.

We should see if we can get photographs or drawings of this altar from Maginnis and make some suggestions for him.

"We think that a shield could well serve as the center of interest. This might be painted on a piece of metal, or even a good sheet of plywood cut to the correct shape, using colors to match the red, white and blue bunting draped at either side. We think that this should be hung on the

outer face of the recess for the altar and reredos rather than against the top of the reredos itself. This will bring it out more in line with the flags. It is hardly necessary to say that the shield should have thirteen vertical stripes - seven white and six red, with a blue chief one-third its length without stars."
