Mr. Walker's criticisms: "It has been suggested that the figure of the Devil is too 'prominent, eye-catching and sprightly'. (Perhaps he could be partially concealed by other parts of the composition." "Also that the stones, the temple and the mountain might be more in evidence."
Feb. 21. Wrote Mr. Walker. "I think we can introduce the stones to good purpose in the pattern surrounding the temple, - that is, just above the temple at Satan's feet."
