I have completed the rough color design for window Number Five, and am sending it to you herewith.

The subjects and compositions remain as you saw them in the pencil sketch, - being devoted to the "Calling of the Disciples to be Fishers of Men" in the right, and "The Sermon on the Mount" in the left.

You will notice that I have carried out the plan to indicate definite characterization to the eight saintly listeners whose lives exemplify the individual qualities of the Eight Beatitudes. Lazarus stands for the Poor in Spirit; Nicodemus, the Just; Saint John the Evangelist, They that Mourn; the Blessed Virgin for the Meek; Saint Paul for the Merciful; Saint John the Baptist for the Persecuted; Saint Agnes, the Clean of Heart; and Saint Stephen, the Peacemakers.

The detail of the canopy will, of course, follow the established plan.
