Restudy sketch. Feb. 1, 1938, Bishop Cross wrote, "First, as we live with these predominately red windows, we feel more and more that they are too red. While we desire the variation in color treatment in the alternate windows, we do feel that we should lean more toward the blue than we have done in several of the other "red" background windows. May I also suggest a restudy of medallion number 1 -- the medallion that has reference to Paul's conversion?"

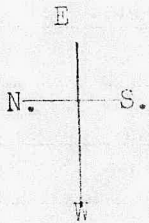
