Apr.14.1938, When sent design said: "We are suggesting a lighter treatment for the chancel windows, in view of their emaller sizes and positions. This would, of course, vary in the several windows to compensate for the differences in exposures, and in the window toward the north, its relation to the tower. These chancel windows might be further enriched with symbols or small figures, the committee would care to consider such a plan. You will see the nature of the design suggests shapes for symbols — or could easily be adjusted as a background for significant figures."
