represents Christ's Passion and Suffering, as the Spirit of True Godliness; opposite St.Zadkiel, bearing a symbol of the ram caught in a thicket, symbolizes the Spirit of Understanding. St.Michael with flaming sword and the scales of justice represent the Spirit of Holy Fear. St. Jophiel, Guardian of the gates of Eden, (with a symbol of the tree of Knowledge beside him). -the Spirit of Ghostly Strength.

Warm vermilion ruby suggests in terms of color symbolism the Divine Love of God while cooler passages of blue symbolize Heavenly Wisdom and Contemplation.
