This includes 3 panels, the 1 1/2" border of all of the work above the case-
ment frame, the colored glass at the peak of the border and the bit of
inset in one of the lower plain panels; all delivered in Worcester and
set complete in place by us.

Mr. miner will cut out the 2 upper rows of glass panels, with the cusp
above, down to the frame of the casement and send it to us with a
template of all of the stone opening above the casement frame.

NOTE: BE SURE TO RETURN TO WORCESTER THE WHOLE PANELS OF THE PRESENT
GLASS WHICH WE DO NOT USE. Also return the color sketch to Mr. Miner
after the work is completed.
