General Information Window in the nature of the Newton, Trinity Church - Angels of Praise and Prayer.  
\*We are to provide new sash for the two main panels and set them in permanently. The two upper pieces can be put in the present sash which are hinged at the bottom to fall in. The frames are painted dark - almost black, sort of a greenish black. (Frame cost to be included in above \$800).  
This is a Cram church (see photograph of interior) which has been greatly revised and altered. A large chancel window blew out in the hurricane and is now replaced with a solid wall. The double-hung sash were removed when the Gethsemane window was put in many years ago. This has large figure groups in rather nondescript color - very much a painted window made by someone about 30 years ago who was just getting his start at that time. It cost \$200.

Description of design: - "Decorative growing vine forms, flowering in roses and fleur-de-lis - traditional symbols of divine love and purity - enrich the field and outline the two dominant medallions devoted to Angels of Prayer and Praise, with censer and psaltery. Around them are stars of heavenly steadfastness. The star motif again appears to enrich the blue border of conventional cloud forms. In the smaller openings above are other members of the angelic host kneeling in prayer, and across the base is the memorial inscription. This design is intended to convey an impression of the window in full brilliant light."
