General Information "The side doors of the central entrance are the same width as those in the side vestibule doors, but ten inches shorter. However, it will cost us just as much to make them, - that is, there will be an equal amount of work involved. Much of the cost is in the installation.

\*The 2 side groups of the central vestibule, receiving outside light, \$140. The tracery over the central door, \$150 - making \$290 in all.
