the Virgin Mother and Child.

Miss Reynolds says - in relation to the Star for Nativity, and Crown for Epiphany, that Mr. Furrer has spoken of a crown already in place - possibly near the medallion on the wall, so he wondered if the crown might be replaced with some other appropriate symbol. Miss Reynolds does not think this is important - just mentioned it in passing.

Important note: Mr. Connick told Miss Reynolds that there were Angels of Praise on the left, and Angels of Prayer on the right. Be sure they are carried out that way.
