In further reply to your letter of January ninth, with your note of January nineteenth before me, I am sending you herewith a rough sketch to suggest my idea for the development of the window in Saint Paul's Lutheran Church of Providence to symbolize The Ascension.

Perhaps with so rough a sketch I might well say by way of introduction that the two standing figures that dominate the narrow panels on the right and left are Saint Mark and Saint Luke in the act of writing, since they are the ones whose Gospels contain the story of the Ascension.

The dominating figure in the center of the larger group may be identified as Saint Peter, and others in the finished window will also be easily identified.

There are small Angels of Prayer (left, and of Praise (right) in the bases of the two narrow panels; and Welcoming Angels in the upper parts of the same panels.

The Love of the Holy Spirit is at the top of the center lancet-panel, and the figure of the Ascending Christ dominates the whole window both in size and in lovely white and tinted glasses.
