General Information * to be set in sash sent here, and set by the church.

Saint John the Evangelist. - represents the symbolic figure of the youthful St. John the Evangelist, holding in his right hand a quill, and supporting in both hands an open book containing the significant passage - St. John 15:13 - "Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends." The background and border are in cool whites, blues and golds, and the symbol of St. John's spiritual flights, the eagle, has a prominent place in the background which is enriched with pomegranates, symbol of the fruitfulness of the good life. The border of clouds and stars symbolize heavenly vistas; and in very small letters at the base of the design on the right is suggested the words "Gift of R.H.B."

For addresses of those to be notified as window progresses, see other side.

C.J.C. said his idea would be to use very beautiful red, ranging from dark to light, with a piece of very beautiful slab - solid gold slabs in places. Figure should face the chancel.

Mrs. Etherington (Mrs. S.G. Etherington, Fortunes Rock, Biddeford, Maine), will send down the frame for the window, and when complete, it should be sent back to her. (7/10/45). *here!*
