General Information Moses, Jacob and Abraham.

The east window is devoted to Moses, Jacob and Abraham, - Moses with the characteristic rays of light from his forehead, holds the tablets of the Law. Jacob bears the symbol of the sun and moon and twelve stars for his twelve sons. Abraham has the brazier of coals and the knife of sacrifice.
