General Information "The Flight into Egypt".
Joseph, with his symbolic flowering staff, leads the donkey that bears Our Lady and the Christ Child. In the field above Our Lady is a symbol of Bethlehem, while in the background near Joseph is the symbol of an angel guiding them on their way. Symbols above suggest the Sacred Monogram of Our Lady and the Heart pierced by the Sword. In the field below are indicated the legend of the palm tree bent to shade the Holy Family and the pyramids of Egypt.
