General Information If the Owners direct, we are to install windows of Cathedral Glass, leaded in simple diamond or rectangular pattern, in the window openings of the Beacon Hill Chapel, where under the agreement we are removing the leaded glass.

~~\*The Pittsburgh price is as above, "for installing a rough surfaced protection glass - probably "factrolite". The glass would be installed in sheets as large as practical with horizontal division leads between sections."~~

We are to install amber glass in sheets. This to be done by the Boston Plate Glass Company (Mr. Damon) for \$1758.00. In addition, we are to supply 5 new ventilators at \$125., which include one at the base of the central panel in the balcony window, and one in each of the end panels at either

side of the nave. Scaffolding by Interior Scaffolding - \$200, plus \$25.00 for removing the one window. The additional cost for using amber glass, over and above the allowance from Boston University of \$1308, is \$239.00. See letter of November 9, 1949 to Dean Meriano. (His additional cost will be \$364.00). (Perhaps give B.U. benefit of saving on Scaffolding.
