General Information "We have studied the medallions for the two apse windows for their best composition and balance in design. The Empress is suggested kneeling and serving St. Martin who is robed, to emphasize in symbolical manner, his high position and importance. The table with the Emperor and a bishop complete the significance of the composition. Designed in this way, the subject nicely balances the companion medallion devoted to the young St. Martin dividing his cloak with the beggar - a very spirited and colorful subject leading to the vision of Christ wearing the severed cloak in the next window."
