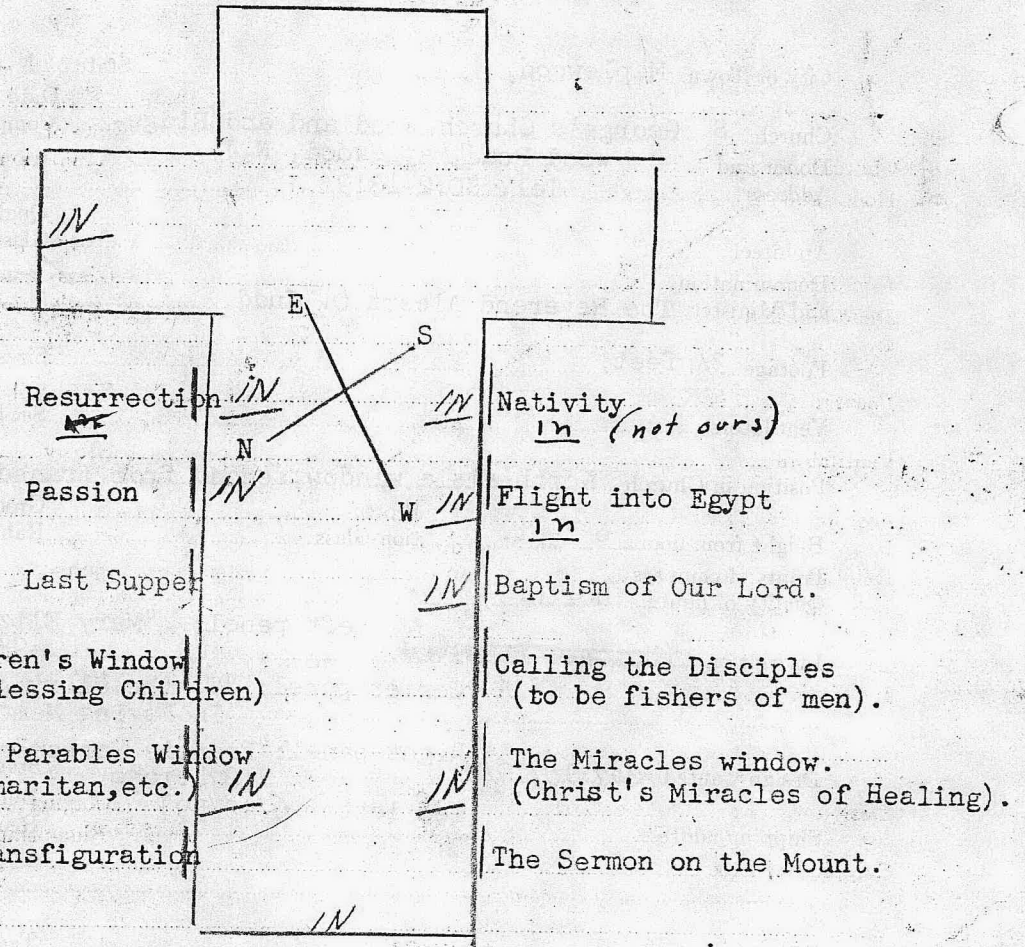

 them, for they know not what they do."
