General Information Three circles above aisle panels: North, nearest chance,
St. Michael; nearest entrance, St. Raphael; *skipped*
South. St. Gabriel. *skipped*
The circle above St. Augustine and St. Benedict is devoted to the
Archangel Michael, who is represented in armor and surcoat bearing the
scales and flaming sword. The circle above St. Ignatius and St. Alphonsus
is devoted to the archangel Gabriel in shining dalmatic bearing the lily
symbol of the Annunciation.
The circle above St. Francis and St. Columbanus is devoted to the
Archangel Raphael, who is represented with the pilgrim's staff and gourd,
and the fish, suggesting his aid to Tobias.
