General Information These windows make it easily possible for the Reception Committee to peer into the church and know when to let late comers in to be seated. Mr. Barber thinks we could put in glass that would still make it possible for one to see from the Narthex into the Nave, or vice versa.

We suggested Noah's Ark and the Barque of Peter to symbolize the Old and New Testaments. Another idea - little kneeling angels of Praise and Prayer, or beautifully designed monograms of Our Lord, the XP and the IHC. Another idea - historical forms of the cross, for instance, the anchor cross.
