Our report to Mr. Timmins, Town Accountant, who first got in touch  
with us: "~~Our craftsman has examined the windows. The trouble is all~~  
in the ventilators of one pair of windows. These are both rusted away  
to a point beyond repair and the glass panel in one of them was broken  
from the pressure of the expanding rusted surfaces. According to our  
records these were International Casement Company ventilators....  
According to Mr. O'Connor, they are never used and our suggestion is  
that they be removed and new sections of stained glass to match the  
old be prepared and installed in the full ventilator space."
