General Information "For the chancel windows we would like a rich color scheme, with the dominant figure of Christ with outstretched hands as if saying "Come Unto Me". On either side of the central lancet - attendant angels of praise and prayer." Grisaille

The color scheme to be controlled enough to prevent glare in the face of the congregation.

Rough design sent Feb. 25, 1947, with photos to illustrate.

The face of the wood frame unscrews to the groove, so that face can be removed, and the window set in bodily. They have double glazing with fine-ribbed protection glass now installed.
