staff and gourd.

Use only the shield, inscribed with the radiant cross on the mount, with  
keys and doves.  
Background, simple grisaille.  
Mr. Groves says existing dividing mullions are of wood and may be removed  
for freedom of design.

Description of design: West window: "The dominating symbol of the Chalice and Host appears in the upper portion of the center panel, while the Seal of the Diocese of California is at the left, and the Seal of Saint James is at the right.

In accordance with our correspondence, we have omitted the lettering of the Seal, the mitre and the scroll in using the Seal of California in order to have it balance well with the traditional Seal of Saint James - the three scallop shells, the pilgrim's hat, staff and gourd.

The lovely foliated background of growing forms is enriched with stars, and gold and ruby flames of steadfastness, divine zeal, and divine love."
