*The building is quite dark inside, so, although the window will face the south, it probably should be bright and colorful. For much of the year here the sun is not too bright.

The ~~design~~ ~~type~~ window gives an excellent opportunity for a lovely figure of Our Lord as the Good Shepherd with the Lamb in His arms; the shepherd's crook; the flying bird for the joy of nature and the grape vine suggesting that significant text: "I am the vine, Ye are the branches". The ruby and white garments suggests in mediaeval color symbolism, divine love and purity, while the blue of the field implies heavenly contemplation.
