General Information "Whatever plan is developed through the aisle windows could either carry into the two at the sides of the entrance and the rose

To have Allegorical figures of Service and Worship. Worship to be symbolized by the attitude of prayer, perhaps holding a small cross. Service, perhaps to have a ~~XXXXXX~~ some symbol of medical aid, - perhaps the caduceus.

On book below Service: "By love serve one another" (Gal. 5:13).

" " " Worship: "Worship at His footstool" (Psalm 99:5). #4274

For addresses of those to be notified as window progresses, see other side.

As planned, they are devoted to allegorical figures of Service and Worship. Service holds the symbol of medical aid, the Caduceus, and the open book is inscribed with the text from Galatians 5:13. "By love serve ~~a~~ one another". Worship holds the cross, and ~~the~~ hook bears the text, - "Worship st His footstool" (Psalm 99:5).

The color scheme and foliated pattern of the field is designed to harmonize with the other windows though somewhat different in acknowledgment of their different size, shape and position.

A space is provided for a memorial inscription.
