

The Abraham Window

In the base of the left lancet, Abraham receives three Angels (Genesis 18:1-16); and the smaller upper medallion symbolizes the significance of the stars (Genesis 15:5).

The right lancet, at the base, shows the Angel forbidding the Sacrifice of Isaac (Genesis 22:11); and in the upper smaller medallion, Abraham discovering the Ram caught in the Thicket (Genesis 22:13).

In the tracery pieces are the six-pointed stars of the Old Dispensation.

The text: "Faith was reckoned to Abraham for Righteousness" (Romans IV:9).

The Moses Window

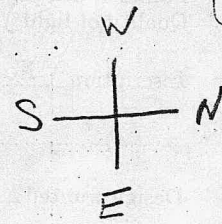
The lower medallion of the left panel shows Moses as the Shepherd in Midian (Exodus 3:1); and the upper medallion symbolizes the Appearance of the Angel of God in the Burning Bush (Exodus 3:2-9).

The lower medallion of the right lancet symbolizes Moses Receiving the Angel of God on Mount Sinai, and Receiving the Tables of the Law (Exodus 19:3 and 24:12).

The upper small medallion symbolizes the Fountain Springing from the Cleft Rock (Exodus 17:6).

The tracery pieces are in cloud forms with six-pointed stars of the Old Dispensation.

The text: "This Moses did God send to be a ruler and a deliverer" (Acts 7:35)
