General Information Cut down two memorial windows replaced by the new ones  
in the chancel, to occupy positions in the aisles.

Geer Memorial is the one with the figure of the Young Christ, and the  
Thompson Memorial is the one with the grape design.  
New inscription, with the same text, to be inserted in the base of the  
Young Christ rather than having a place cut in the lower ornamental  
portion.

In the Thompson window, with the ornamental design, we can eliminate the  
upper unit of the field, bringing the decorative canopy down about  
18 inches.

The Geer window, with the Young Christ - will be cut in 3 places. The  
canopy will have to be brought down, the portion above the canopy will

also have to be lowered and a section will have to be taken out below the feet of the figure.

The window with the grape design and the vent goes nearest the organ.
