General Information "The Nativity", above; Annunciation below - canopy, like
aisle window sketches. *Presentations*

Description of design: "The divisions of the window offer an excellent
opportunity for a combination of the Annunciation and Nativity scenes. *Presentations*
Below we have the angel of the Annunciation appearing to the Blessed Virgin,
kneeling in prayer, with the descending dove above, and the text, "Blessed
art thou among Women." Presentations, in one panel the ancient Simeon holds the*
The dominant panels above symbolize the Nativity with the Blessed Virgin
reclining, holding the Holy Child, balanced by the kneeling St. Joseph with
his flowering staff and the ox and ass above.

Both compositions are placed under rustic construction to suggest a stable

with its thatched roof. The scroll below bears the text, "Unto you is born a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord."

Kneeling angels occupy the two principal tracery pieces above. The field is designed in decorative architectural canopy similar to that in the other windows.

*Christ Child, while the other are Mary and Joseph. Joseph bears the sacrificial gift of doves.

NOTE: The rector wrote: "The matter of more symbolism in the window had better be left to your judgment. It is difficult to tell from the colored sketch all that is intended to be in it. We do want the window to mean much to our children. Under the window is a side altar and there each Wednesday afternoon about 50 of our Junior Girls Friendly hold their closing service. On Sundays at the opening service of the Church School the little ones assemble in the front pews of the nave near the window." We wrote "We shall study the window in its special relation to children".
