"We have kept the field in very light tones to admit an bundance of illumination, at the same time patterning it with growing foliated vine forms to preserve a quality of full rich color. The dominant figure of Abraham holds the brazier of fire and the sacrificial knife, while little symbols of the sacrificial altar and the ram caught in the thicket are indicated at each side.

The figure of Isaac is represented below at the left, carrying wood for the fire, balanced by Joseph with the sheaf of wheat. Below is Jacob with the

symbolic ladder.

The border is enriched with the pomegranate motif, the traditional symbol of the unity and fruitfulness of the church."
