(We may eventually do all five windows). The minister says the foliage shown on the bulletin cover is not as heavy as it shows. He also enclosed a photograph with no foliage.

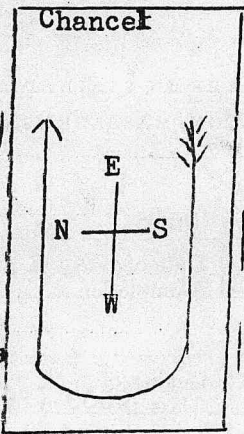
