General Information The three main figures - Saul, David and Solomon, going from
right to left toward the chancel.
The first window on the north side, symbolizes the United Kingdom, - first,
in its simple beginnings with Saul. The young giant is represented with
shield and spear above the feast which Samuel prepared for him. At the right,
Saul is represented searching for his father's asses, the journey that led to
his meeting with Samuel. At the left he is symbolized battling with the
Philistines.
The central figure represents King David with his triumph over Goliath. At
the right is the young shepherd and at the left, the sweet singer of Israel
playing before Saul.
The third panel commemorates Solomon. He holds a model of the temple above
a symbol of its building. His celebrated judgment between the two claimants
of the child is at the right, and the Queen of Sheba at the left.
