General Information C.J.C.'s report of his visit there said, "St. Mark's is cool in color and will not challenge the proposed windows. ...I showed the window in the Perkins Institute Chapel as a suggestion."  
The Twelve Fruit of the Holy Spirit - an amplification in Christian Art of St. Paul's words in Galatians 5:22 - "Love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, goodness, courage, humility, faith, hope, purity, temperance". Since these windows are in twin lancets, I like the idea of honoring masculine and feminine characters together under each subject."  
Heaton, Butler and Bayne installed the window in the east wall and another small one in the baptistry.
