Description of Design:

Aisle window, second from transept on the north side.

This symbolizes Christ before Pilate and the Crucifixion.

In the lower medallion Christ is represented standing before Pilate with a guard nearby.

Above, Christ on the cross is accompanied by His mother Mary, and Saint John the Evangelist with book and pen as recorder of this most significant incident.
