General Information Repair: "They have a simple, rectangular clear glass, leaded office door, in which the putty and flat bars have come loose. Some of the lead flange has peeled off. It will probably have to be taken out for repairs, and two new bars should be added.

Then there are 6 or 8 broken pieces in various office windows that should be placed, - clear glass, rectangular leads:
