

General Information All windows get good light. These windows have 1" horizontal bars in the protection glass, half way in the space above the vents.

These windows are to have medallions, one the Baptism of Christ by Saint John the Baptist; the other, Christ Blessing little Children.

All the windows are in positions where light and brilliance is essential.

Phillips measurements are full sizes. There are 1/2" stops.

We have suggested both Baptistry windows, devoting one to the Baptism of Our Lord by Saint John the Baptist, with a significant text on the open book below: "This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased." (Saint Matthew 3:17). The other represents Our Lord blessing little Children, with the text, "Suffer children to come to me, and forbid them not", (Saint Luke 18:16). These Baptistry windows, as well as those in the Narthex, have goodly passages of light glass, so that the areas they illuminate will not become sober.
