General Information "The owner has expressed a desire to have windows which will not exclude too much light from the interior of the Church..."

These windows, not more than square seen from church floor - see notation on layout: Rail  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches from glass.

On the stairs to the front balcony, represent St. Gregory in the West or Gospel side, and St. ~~Cecilia~~ in the east, with symbols of music in the heads of the windows. Pius X in the east.
