The windows of Offices 102 and 107, are designed in a similar manner, with symbols suggesting the medical and nursing professions, - the caduceus, the lamp, and the Red Cross; and the mortar and pestle, the stethoscope and the sunlamp.

Vestibule, Corridor and Offices 102 and 107:

These windows are designed in carefully proportioned leaded patterns of plain clear glass, with the exception of Window C-10 on the stair landing to the Chapel, which is further enriched in light tints and accented by a colorful border and central floral motif.
