General Information The north aisle windows are devoted to Prophets and
Patriarchs. We have contract for Isaiah #3063. - Jan

This window to be devoted to Jeremiah with broken chains, suggesting freedom
from bondage, and the prophet's scroll inscribed with the text, "O earth,
hear the word of the Lord".

The medallion at the left suggests an incident somewhat similar to that
of Isaiah's, when the vision of the Lord inspired Jeremiah to eloquence. The
Lord touches his mouth to "put my words in thy mouth" (Jeremiah 1:9).

Opposite is his vision of the Almond Tree, which follows in the same
Chapter.
