General Information Figures of Saints Patrick and Columba - Cranmer and Seabury to represent personalities significant in Church History.

To be light windows, as they need light in the Church.
Cranmer, died at stake, Oxford 1556 - Archbishop of Canterbury, Author of Prayerbook and 39 articles. (Chancel is east.)
Seabury, Samuel, First P.E. Bishop in America - organized American P.E. Church, and revised prayerbook.
Patrick - Bishop of Ireland, Patron Saint.
Columba - Founder of Christian Mission to Picts and Scotland - Founder of two Irish Monasteries.
