General Information To be a full, rich color window, as in the Portland color plate, with a dominant medallion devoted to Christ Blessing Little Children, something like the one in our aisle window at Saint John's Church, Newtonville, but in a composition more like the windows in Saint John's, Florence.

Avoid rectangles, have flowing scrolls, include notes of green in the window, include some shamrocks, a harp, and indicate five children.

Note: Color design lost in the mails.

We have completed our study of the design  
for your Baptistry window, and are sending you  
the color sketch herewith.

As planned, it is designed in pure, rich  
color, and is devoted to the theme of Christ  
Blessing Little Children.

Our Lord is seated and holds a small child  
in his arms, while four more are grouped  
around Him.

The ruby field is enriched with a decorative  
growing vine pattern flowering in the white fleur-  
de-lys of purity. The red rose of divine love is  
represented below and in the tracery mullers; the  
Harp of heavenly praise in the head of the panel  
and shamrocks, symbol of the Trinity, through the  
field near the borders.
